However, it is listed in Wieslanders collection of Bruun's works ("Notsamling") as a polska, not a waltz. This transcription is from the Wieslander version (opus 66). A note on the manuscript claims it originates from Poland and was brought to Sweden during the reign of Charles XII (that is, the early 1700s). The harmony part was composed by Ralsgård.
